

# Rules of Broadclyst Victory Hall

Regarding the sale of alcohol & conduct on these premises

The responsible Adult\* is sanctioned by the DPS Martin Arthurs and has agreed and signed the following terms and conditions

<b>It is an offence to serve alcohol to any person less than 18 years of age.</b>
<b>It is an offence for an 18 year old and over to purchase alcohol for a person under 18 years old.</b>
<b>It is an offence to serve someone alcohol who is intoxicated or appears to be.</b>
<b>It is an offence to serve alcohol to someone who intends to supply a drunken person.</b>
<b>It is an offence to serve alcohol outside the hours stated on the Premises licence.</b>

If in doubt about the age of a person attempting to purchase alcohol you should ask for proof of age.

The following documents are acceptable in all circumstances

Passport / U.K. Drivers Licence / Portman and Citizens Cards. *No others should be accepted*

Date of birth should be on or before ( date of event less 18 years )

## **You must be able to:**

<b>Ensure the fire doors are unlocked and take charge in the event of a fire.</b>
<b>Take appropriate action in the event of accidents and injuries occurring on the premises.</b>

The above rules are necessary in order to comply with licensing objectives which are:

<b>The prevention of crime and disorder.</b>
<b>Public safety.</b>
<b>The prevention of public nuisance.</b>
<b>The protection of children from harm.</b>
